## **Effective Training for NEET’s-**

The ET-NEET’s project will soon be entering its second year, with great progress so far it is time for an update on our work, key achievements and upcoming programmes.

Receiving funding in 2014 an EU wide group of local councils, authorities, social services and training providers combined to help tackle the challenge of providing an effective solution to reduce the 5.5 million young people between the ages of 15-24 who are either unemployed, not in education or training in the EU28. Our aim is focused on creating a common framework for successful training practices across the EU for NEET’s.

## **Questionnaires prove a great success**

ET-NEET’s team have been hard at work with the first phase of the project: distributing and collecting data and information from the questionnaires from both organisations directly linked to the NEET’s such as; local authorities, councils, social services, VET providers, charities and NGO’s and have provided the ET-NEET’s team with a great insight into current practice, effectiveness of training and areas needing improvement. In total over 3000 questionnaires were distributed and made available online or in hard copy for participants to complete.

Currently, we are in the process of interpreting and analysing the large amount of data we have received and the results will be published in the autumn on the ET-NEET’s website.

## **Critical NEET Development Courses Topics Agreed**

In June 2015, all ET-NEET’s project partners met in Rzeszow, Poland to discuss the upcoming NEET development courses that are being developed within the project and offered to targeted young people. Key topics and programmes agreed for inclusion in the course included: leadership, organisation, communication skills, employability, inclusion, diversity of life barriers and a particular focus placed on entrepreneurial skills. Four young people from Poland will participate in the course organised by the UK partner in London, Teach Sport and another four from the UK will take part in the course organised by Spanish partner, Sea Teach in Mallorca.
